

Up Lighting

Up lighting is likely the most popular element of ambient lighting at events, commonly used to illuminate the perimeter of a space and highlight specific points of interest such as bars, drape entryways, and stage backgrounds. These up lights utilize advanced RGBWA+UV color mixing, which allows for more variety in color options than many other fixtures including soft pastels to vibrant colors such as hot pink or lime green.

How it Works

Up lights are placed on the floor, and angled towards the walls (or points of interest), and spaced a few feet apart from each other to fill the space. The number of up lights used in a space will depend on the size of the area, and the spacing chosen by the designer (and accommodated for in client budget) in order to achieve the desired effect.



Recommended Strategies

We can provide dynamic up lighting that can be programmed to subtly shift and shimmer throughout the event, or be triggered to dramatically change at a certain point.
